



Senior High College Scholarship

Purpose

To encourage and support individuals from, or associated with, Salem Lutheran Church to pursue higher education, with a preference given to religious studies.

Qualification Criteria

1. The applicant, or applicant's family must be a member of Salem Lutheran Church, Lenexa, KS, or associated with Salem Lutheran Church.
2. The applicant must be accepted by an accredited college or university as a full-time student.
3. Preference will be given, but not required, to enrollment in:
 - a. Lutheran Seminary
 - b. Lutheran College/University
 - c. Other Christian College/University
4. The applicant will be evaluated and selected on the following criteria:
 - a. Having attained a grade point average of 2.5 or higher
 - b. Demonstrated qualities of leadership, service, and character
 - c. Involvement in Church or extra curricular, school sponsored, activities
 - d. Financial need
 - e. Completion of an essay on one of the following topics:
 - What my faith means to me.
 - Elaboration of my church activities.
 - Why community service is important to me.

Payments

The scholarship payment of \$500 will be awarded to the recipient after proof of full-time enrollment is submitted, no later than October 31 of the student's Freshman year of attendance. Enrollment must be verified by the Admission's Office of the educational institution.

Selection

Members of our Human Resource Team are responsible for the interpretation of the guidelines and making the recommendation of the recipient to the Church Council.

The scholarship is intended for first year students, but may be renewed if there are no qualifying applicants in any year. Exceptions may be made for students entering the Seminary.
