C: ⁸Trust in him at all times, O people;
pour out your heart before him;
God is a refuge for us.

**L: ⁹Those of low estate are but a breath,
those of high estate are a delusion;
in the balances they go up;
they are together lighter than a breath.**

C: ¹⁰Put no confidence in extortion,
and set no vain hopes on robbery;
if riches increase, do not set your heart on them.

**L: ¹¹Once God has spoken;
twice have I heard this:
that power belongs to God,**

C: ¹²and steadfast love belongs to you, O LORD.
For you repay to all
according to their work.
