C: <sup>2</sup>Let Israel be glad in its Maker; let the children of Zion rejoice in their King.

**L: <sup>3</sup>Let them praise his name with dancing, making melody to him with tambourine and lyre.**

C: <sup>4</sup>For the LORD takes pleasure in his people; he adorns the humble with victory.

**L: <sup>5</sup>Let the faithful exult in glory; let them sing for joy on their couches.**

C: <sup>6</sup>Let the high praises of God be in their throats and two-edged swords in their hands,

**L: <sup>7</sup>to execute vengeance on the nations and punishment on the peoples,**

C: <sup>8</sup>to bind their kings with fetters and their nobles with chains of iron,

**L: <sup>9</sup>to execute on them the judgment decreed. This is glory for all his faithful ones. Praise the LORD!**
